Shalom Task Force was founded in 1992 when a Long Island pediatrician approached female leaders in the community to discuss a problem he was seeing: Jewish women and children with bruises. In response, a group of women came together to address the "uncomfortable" problem of domestic abuse in Jewish homes and developed it into a national organization. Shalom Task Force facilitates several educational programs and workshops (including one for engaged couples), as well as a confidential hotline staffed by more than 80 volunteers that fields 1,200 calls per year from victims of domestic abuse.
